

Monthly Sales by Retail Channel




OlA's Product Spotlight

The combination of holiday sales and good snow, made November a great month for rack sales. Snow sports alone were up 63% over the same period last year, closely followed by hitch racks up 52%. Many are attributing the rise in sales to booming SUV and truck sales. According to SEMA* "In the \$43-billion automotive specialty equipment market, products for pickup trucks accounted for 29% in 2017". In addition the global forecast for roof racks is expected to grow 7%^{**} by 2023. 
Tariffs collected on aluminum products in October alone, have already accounted for an increase of \$124M over the same period last year.




Cotton Price (dollar per kg.)
